**Subject: How would you invite your friends to become a member of Spirit of America Federal Credit Union?**

**Eligibility:** Participant must have a GED or be a high school graduate, must be enrolled or plan to enroll in college (junior, community, state or university) in calendar year 2018. Participant **MUST** be a member of Spirit of America Federal Credit Union as of December 31, 2017. Spirit of America Federal Credit Union employees, volunteers and their immediate family members are eligible as "blind judging" is utilized.

**Requirements:** Maximum of 500 words, must be typed, using 12 point font, and be double spaced. Essays must be submitted in English. Essays will be judged based upon originality, relevance to topic, grammar and spelling. As the essays will be blind judged, do not put your name on the essay; use a cover sheet that contains the following information:

1. Full name
2. Account number at Spirit of America FCU
3. Home street address, city, state, zip code
4. Phone number
5. Email address
6. College/University attending in Fall of 2018



Essays must be received at Spirit of America Federal Credit Union (by hand delivery or US mail) on or before 5:00 p.m. March 31, 2018.

**Winners Announced:** Scholarship winners will receive free tickets to the Credit Union's Annual Meeting when their "Certificate of Award" will be presented. Scholarship funds will be paid directly to the institution the student is or will be enrolled in the Fall of 2018.
